Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING; the 2001-2004 ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA); this notice of race and by the Sailing Instructions, all of which supplement or modify the former.

Entries/Eligibility: All Registered PCISA Member Schools are welcome. Each school may enter as many boats as desired by completing the entry form(s) and Release of Liability Form (signed by Parent or Guardian) attached.

Entries must be mailed (postmarked) or faxed to the San Francisco YC by September 29 @ 5pm.

Format: This will be a non-rotational regatta. The boat brought will be the boat sailed in all races. This changes ISSA Rule 7.6(a).

Racing Area/Spectating/Coaching: Races will be held in Clipper Cove just south of the Navy Sea Plane Hangars. There should be excellent spectating from the Treasure Island Sailing Center.

Parking/Boat Storage: Boat, trailer and parking space will be limited. Please maximize efficiency by loading trailers full (trailer pooling), bring dollies for each boat and car pool as much as possible.

Safety: US Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type 3, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.
