1 RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by: the Racing Rules of Sailing, RRS 2005-2008 (including Appendix D), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules 2005-2008, the rules of the CFJ Class, and by the Notice of Race except as modified by the Sailing Instructions. CFJ class rules requiring class membership and minimum crew weight shall not apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. A team is comprised of a maximum of nine sailors. Schools must be registered with PCISA/ISSA in order to compete. Eligible teams may enter by completing the Entry Form and submitting it to the OA no later than Wednesday, April 20th, 2005.

3 FEES

3.1. The Entry fee is \$30 per team, made payable to San Diego Yacht Club. Fee may be paid at registration.

4 EQUIPMENT

4.1. Each team must provide at least one class legal CFJ for use in the event. Contact Robbie Dean for charter possibilities. Sails will be provided by PCISA.
4.2. Boats will be inspected prior to the first race as part of a teams' official entry.
4.3. Competitors will be responsible for damage to boats as a result of a foul or negligence.

5 SCHEDULE

5.2. The race committee will attempt to sail as many races as possible on Saturday. Plan to spend two full days of racing.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided at check-in.

7 VENUE

7.1. Races will be sailed in the La Playa Basin adjacent to San Diego Yacht Club.

8 COURSE

8.1. The course will be a "Digital N". The race committee may also use a triangle with port or starboard roundings as described in the ISSA Procedural Rules. Target race time will be set to accomplish a full rotation.

9 SCORING

9.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with the ISSA Procedural Rules.

10 RACING FORMAT

10.1. At minimum, a single round robin will be completed. Further races may be sailed at the discretion of the race committee.

11 JUDGING/ PROTESTS

11.1. Judges may be on the water using the observer system of RRS Appendix D (D2.3). If so, the group will be comprised of local judges and other qualified juror/umpire types. ISSA Procedural Rules Appendix 4. Details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions. Protests will be handled in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule #16. Jury will hear all protests on the water or in a designated location determined by the Race Committee.

12 COACHING

12.1. ISSA Procedural Rule #8 "COACHING" shall apply, except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1 "Helping those in Danger".

13 AWARDS

13.1. Teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall will qualify to participate in the Baker Trophy National Championship in Jensen Beach, FL on May 28-29, 2005 being sailed in 420s.

14 ACCOMIDATION

14.1. Local hotels and motels are in close proximity to San Diego Yacht Club. Check <http://sdyc.org/raceinfo/links.htm> and click the link to "local hotels".

15 OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL BAKER ELIMS PARTICIPANTS

15.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages, (beer, wine, or spirits), or any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. Infringements of this regulation and/or other off water discipline expectations occurring during April 23-24, 2005 may be the basis for disciplinary action. Discipline problems and the enforcement of this regulation will be handled promptly by an adult Discipline Hearing Board selected by the Organizing Authority, to be composed of three adult members: the Regatta Chairperson or designee, a member of the PCISA Board of Directors or designee, and the Chief Judge or designee. This Board shall, at a time and method selected by it, meet to hear and review any problems. The Board, in its sole judgment, may decide to impose scoring penalties or other sanctions, including summary removal from the regatta. The decision of the Board shall be final and not subject to appeal.
