NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rule of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US SAILING, and the Team Racing Rules (Appendix D), except as any of these are altered by the Sailing instructions.

2. BOATS & FACILITIES

- 2.1 Competing teams are to bring their own class legal CFJs for the regatta. Competitors will not rotate boats during the regatta. A few boats will be available for charter. Interested parties should contact Eric Anderson at 650-854-1048 or at hiker4u@aol.com.
- 2.2 Competitors will use the public launch facilities (hereafter "public launch") near the corner of Saginaw and Chesapeake. On Saturday, the registration, competitor's meeting and brief team race instruction will be held at the public launch. The debrief and trophy presentation will be held at the Sequoia Yacht Club.

3. TEAMS

- 3.1 Each competing team shall consist of three skippers, three crews and three boats. Teams are free to bring alternates and replacements which may be substituted between races. We ask that you name your team. ie. Fatty fo Fatty, Yappy dogs, etc
- 3.2 The regatta will be limited to eight complete team race teams. This will be determined on a first register basises. You may enter more then one team.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Completed entry forms (see attached) are due to Eric Anderson no later than Wednesday, November 3 2004. Send via fax 650-854-1048 or email at hiker4u@aol.com. One check for the entry fee, (\$15 per competitor) payable to the Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation must filed with regatta personnel before the competitor's meeting on Saturday, November 6th.

6. FEES

- 6.1 An entry fee of \$15 will apply to each competitor including alternates. The entry fee will include instruction before the regatta on Saturday morning and a debrief on Saturday evening. Standard Muffin and Bagel Breakfast Sat Morning and a B-B-Q lunch Saturday for each Competitor. Parents/Coaches can also buy lunch.
- 6.2 Competitors will be required to pay their share of damage caused by collisions, as deemed appropriate by the protest committee.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration at the public launch.

9. FORMAT

9.1 Subject to weather conditions, competitors will engage in a continuous round robin with no limit to the number of races. There will be no separate championship series, and there will be no rotation of boats—each team responsible for its own equipment and sailing in the same boats throughout. Weaker teams may be augmented by coach participation as deemed appropriate by the race committee. The race committee will endeavor to get as many races off as possible offering the greatest exposure to team racing possible.

10. RACING AREA AND COURSE

10.1 A triangle-windward/ or digital N course will be set in Redwood Creek.

11. SCORING

11.1 Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix D, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

12. COACHING

12.1 Coaching will be allowed between races, on or off the water. There will be no coaching during the races.

13. PROTESTS

13.1 Races will be officiated by the competitors and by on-the-water judging by selected regatta personnel.

13.2 Protests not covered by competitor exoneration or by on-the-water judging will be heard as soon as possible by a coach or committee of coaches. Protests will be determined by “3 minute justice”, each competitor having “60 seconds” to explain her position to an officiate and the decision coming 60 seconds thereafter.

13.3 Decisions made by on the water judges and by 3 minute justice are final.

15. TROPHIES:

Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place teams. Because we cannot possibly offer plaques for all team members. We will have one award Placque/Cup per team.
