Racing will be in the turning basin

1. Rules: U.S.S.A 2005-2008 as modified by PCISA, ISSA, NOR-CAL sailing and Sailing Instructions at regatta.

1.2 Each boat will be required to display issued bow numbers.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY & ENTRY FEE, REGISTRATION

2.1 These Regattas are open to all High School Teams
Teams may enter by filing an entry with Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation (PYSF), using the accompanying Entry form, by **Nov. 16, 2005**. Fee may be paid on regatta day.

2.2 **Entry Fee:** The entry fee is **\$25.00 per competitor**, Make checks payable to **PYSF**. Fee will include Continental breakfast, Lunch and awards.

2.3 Schools may enter as many teams as they chose. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different schools. If your school has more than one team please enter as team 1, 2, 3 etc.

3. BOAT:

3.1 Each entered team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ and one class legal set of sails (main and jib). **There will be no formal rotations.**

3.2 It is the intent to have A & B divisions START separately.

3.3 After two races, time will be allowed (determined by RC) for those who wish to substitute in. This will be done on the water.

Sailing instructions: Will be available during regatta & the skippers meeting

Substitutions: will be allowed on the water between races

Protests. Change of format. '3 Minute Justice' each party to a protest selects another competitor (not a team member) as a judge. Each party then has a SINGLE minute to tell their story and the judges have a SINGLE minute to make a decision. RC or scoring official shall be present to record result only. USTRA.
