



2005 ANTEATER REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE

December 10-11, 2005

Hosted at Newport Harbor Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the ISSA procedural rules.
- 1.2 USGG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. All competitors must supply their own PFD's.
- 1.3 Each entered team is required to provide one (1) class legal CFJ.
- 1.4 Each boat is required to display CF numbers and a current year sticker. Boats without valid registration will not be allowed in the rotation and the team supplying the boat will be ineligible to sail.
- 1.5 Each boat is required to use a sail issued by PCISA.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to teams which are current members of PCISA.
- 2.2 Competitors must be accompanied by a designated adult chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach or parent.
- 2.3 Each eligible team may enter one varsity team which shall consist of two (2) skippers and two (2) crews and their alternates.
- 2.4 Junior Varsity teams are eligible for entry after being approved by PCISA, and shall consist of two (2) skippers and two (2) crews, and their alternates. Interested JV teams should contact Tim Hogan, (714) 434-4400 for approval.
- 2.5 Completed entry forms and \$100 entry fee payable to NHYC must be filed with Newport Harbor Yacht Club on or before Wednesday, December 7, 2005. **Late entries will not be accepted.** * Please refer to the attached document 'Event Information' for other information regarding entry fees.*

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-in on Saturday, December 10, 2005.

5. FORMAT

- 5.1 Each Fleet Varsity (GOLD) and Jr. Varsity (SILVER), will be divided into two divisions, A and B. Fleet allocation will be done by PCISA.
- 5.2 All races will be sailed in a Round Robin format. The number of races will be based on the number of entrants.

6. COURSE

- 6.1 The racing area will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 6.2 The course may be any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.



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7. SCORING

- 7.1 A minimum of three races for each division will constitute a series.
- 7.2 The Low-Point Scoring system of Appendix A will apply, except that each boat's score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

8. COACHING/SPECTATOR BOATS

- 8.1 Coach boats and spectator boats will not be provided.
- 8.2 Coach boats and spectator boats will stay off the course at all times, and shall have no contact with any competitor who is *racing* except when rendering assistance under RRS 1.1, or as directed by the Race Committee.
- 8.3 The penalty for failing to comply with these requirements will be dealt with in accordance to the ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded the Gold and Silver fleet, skipper and crew placing 1st – 5th in each division, as soon as possible after the last race.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 Competitors shall comply with any reasonable request from any official, including while at attendance at official functions, and shall not behave so as to bring the event into disrepute. The penalty for breaking the SI is at the discretion of the PC and may include exclusion from further participation in the event, or the withdrawal of any prize.
- 10.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

RACE ENTRY AGREEMENT, WAIVER AND RELEASE

2005 Anteater Regatta
December 10-11, 2005

In consideration of Newport Harbor Yacht Club ("NHYC") accepting my entry in the Regatta or otherwise permitting me to participate in the Regatta, I agree as follows:

1. **COMPLIANCE WITH RULES:** I agree to comply with all rules and regulations of NHYC, US Sailing, USCG and other rules under which the Regatta is sailed. If my boat is moored/stored at NHYC before, during or after the Regatta, I understand that NHYC may move the boat, or adjust and/or modify the mooring, and NHYC is hereby released from any liabilities, and shall incur no liability, as a result of such action.
2. **CONSENT:** I hereby grant NHYC the right to use my name, picture, image, voice and sports performance in the possible creation of promotion and advertising for NHYC and its sailing/racing programs and other regattas. This consent is given only for promotion and advertising of NHYC and its sailing/racing programs and other regattas; consent is not given with respect to the promotion and advertising of any commercial product or service.
3. **WAIVER OF LIABILITY:** I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives and assigns forever release, remise, discharge and agree to save and hold harmless and indemnify NHYC, its members, directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers and owners and lessees of premises, upon which the activities are held, the participants therein and the owner and lessees of all racing equipment used therein (herein referred to as "the Releasees") of and from any and all liability, claims, actions, and possible causes of action whatsoever, including negligence of any of the foregoing that may accrue to me, my heirs and personal representatives and assigns from every and any loss, damage and injury (including death) that may be sustained by me, and my property while in, about, and en route into and out of the premises and property upon which the Regatta is held.
4. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I am aware that the activities involve inherent risks and potentially hazardous conditions which may include, among other things, maneuvering a boat on deep waters, strong winds and high waves, sudden unexpected immersion in deep waters, and collision with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings, piers and buoys. I ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS TO MYSELF OF INJURY, DEATH, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES AND THE USE OF THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY OF NHYC, SPECIFICALLY INCLUDING ANY INJURY OR DAMAGE CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF ANY OF THE RELEASEES.
5. **INDEMNITY AGREEMENT:** I agree to indemnify, defend and hold the Releasees harmless from any loss, liability, damage or cost, including reasonable attorney's fees, they may sustain or incur due to or relating to my participation in the Regatta and use of the property and facilities of Newport Harbor Yacht Club, specifically including any such loss, liability, damage or cost resulting from the negligence or other action, of the Releasees.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THE AGREEMENT INCLUDES A WAIVER OF LIABILITY, AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND AN AGREEMENT BY ME TO INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES, AND I SIGN IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL.
