- 1. Organizing authority.** Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation @ Sequoia Yacht Club

- 2. Regatta chairman- Eric Anderson, PRO- David Kenny.**
- 3. Rules.** The regatta will be governed by the 2004-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing (including appendices governing team racing), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by PCISA), the rules of the CFJ class and PCISA regarding CFJs (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions or the ISSA Procedural Rules); and by the Sailing Instructions.  
**NOTE: Race Participation (RP) forms will be required.**
- 4. Venue** The venue will be Port Of Redwood City Turning Basin. Course: Digital "N" .
- 5. Entry: ENTRY FORM MUST BE RECEIVED OR BEFORE APRIL 21, 2006.** Send to PYSF – Baker Elims, Attn: Eric Anderson, 120 N. Balsamina Way Portola Valley Ca. 94028 or fax to 650-854-1048.
- 6. Fees:** Entry fee is \$210 per Team (6), made payable to PYSF. Barbeque lunches Sat/Sun., Sat. Dinner and Sunday Breakfast included. Alternate sailors fee \$26.00 to cover meals. See Entry Form for details. Valid, fully completed entry forms must be received by Friday April 21, 2006. Entries will be limited to the first ten teams responding.
- 7. Format & Eligibility.** One team (consisting of skippers and crews for three boats) may enter from each PCISA member school. Wind and weather conditions will determine the ultimate format employed by the Race Committee The Race Committee will attempt to complete at least one full round robin, and final 4, which may result in a long day on Sunday. Please make travel plans accordingly.
- 8. Boats.** Boats will be provided by PYSF. Sails will be provided by PCISA. If damage is done to any of the boats or sails, the team or teams that cause the damage will be required to pay for repairs to or replacement of the damaged materials. If it is not possible to ascertain which team caused the damage, each team will be required to pay its pro-rata share of costs to make repairs or replace damaged material.
- 9. Medical Release/Consent Form: Form must be completed and submitted to PYSF for each competitor prior to competing**

**11. Housing.** PYSF cannot offer housing for all participants. Housing will be allocated according to the date we receive each team's completed entry form.

**12. Judging/Protests. Judges, umpires or observers will be on the water. They will act in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules, Appendix 4. Judges may use the "yellow flag rule". Clarification will be provided in the SI's.**

**13. Decisions of the jury.** Decisions of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS Rule 70.4

**14. Sailing instructions.** Sailing Instructions will be available at the Competitor's Meeting.

**15. Coaching.** ISSA Procedural Rule #8, "Coaching", shall apply, except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, "Helping those in danger".

**16. Awards.** The teams placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> will qualify to participate in the Baker Cup Championship regatta.

**17. Official Notices.** No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine and distilled spirits), or any controlled substance (Marijuana, cocaine, etc), the possession of which is unlawful. Infringement of this regulation and/or other off water discipline expectations occurring during April 28-29, 2001 may be the basis for disciplinary action. Discipline problems and enforcement of this regulation will be handled promptly by a Discipline Hearing Board which will consist of three adult members appointed by the Regatta Chairman. The Discipline Hearing Board shall, at a time and method selected by it, meet to hear any discipline problem, and its decision to impose scoring penalties or other sanctions, as they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the entire regatta, shall be final without appeal permitted.

Parental consent & waiver of liability, assumption of risk & indemnity agreement

The undersigned parents or legal guardians, (hereinafter referred to in the singular) of the below named child ("Child" or "Sailor"), request that the Sailor be allowed to participate at the 2006 PCISA Team Race Pacific Coast Championships, ("Regatta"), held under the auspices of Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation (PYSF) Sequoia Yacht Club and utilizing the facilities of the Port Of Redwood City April 29-30, 2006.

This agreement shall remain in effect until the earlier of the Sailor listed below leaving the regatta venue under the supervision and in care of an appropriate adult chaperone or May 1, 2006.

In return for the sailor being permitted to take part in the activities and to use the facilities and property of PYSF and Sequoia Yacht Club, (the "Regatta Providers", or "RP"), each of us makes the following promises and warrants the truth of the following facts:

I am familiar with sailboat racing and regatta activities, and I understand officers, members, employees and volunteers of RP are available to discuss the activities if I should wish additional information. I understand I am solely responsible for the transportation to and from the Regatta, and the arrival and departure of my child at the beginning and end of each day's activity. I will not allow my child to attend the Regatta without appropriate supervision. I agree that the RP will have no responsibility for the direct supervision of my child. The Adult Chaperone named on the Regatta Entry Form and/or myself, if present, will be responsible for my child. I will inform my child that he/she is expected to cooperate with, and follow the directions of the Adult Chaperone, and all persons in charge of the activities and to act in a manner consistent with the spirit of good sportsmanship, the Regatta rules and respect for the rights of others.

Consent: My child is in good health, and I know of no reason why he/she should be incapable of participating in the activities. I consent to my child's participation in the regatta. My child knows how to swim. I will immediately notify the designated RP at the Regatta site if a change in my child's health or other condition would affect my child's ability to participate in the activities.

Waiver of Liability: I waive and release any right I, my child, my heirs, distributees, guardians, legal representatives and assigns may have or acquire to make a claim against, sue, attach the property of, or prosecute any RP or its members, directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers and affiliated organization (hereinafter referred to as "Released Parties") for monetary or other damages caused by injury to my child, or damage to the property of my child or myself, arising from my child's participation in the activities and use of the facilities and property of any RP, whether or not the injury or damage results from the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the Released Parties. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph \_\_\_\_\_)**

Assumption of Risk: I am aware that the activities will involve maneuvering and being on a boat or other watercraft on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include strong and high winds, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings and buoys. With knowledge of the dangers involved, I voluntarily ask that my child be allowed to take part in the activities. I ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISK TO MYSELF AND MY CHILD OF INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES AND USE OF THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY OF ANY RP, whether or not caused by the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the releases. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph \_\_\_\_\_)**

Indemnity Agreement: I agree to indemnify and hold the Released Parties harmless from any loss, liability, damage or cost, including reasonable attorney fees they may incur due to my child's participation in the activities and use whether or not such loss, liability, damage or cost results from the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the Released Parties. **(Please initial to indicate you have read this paragraph \_\_\_\_\_)**
