**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1.0 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the 2005-2008 ISSA Procedural Rules (PR), this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions), and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.
- 1.3 RRS 75.3 shall not apply.

**2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 All competing schools must be members of ISSA. A team is comprised of one competitor.
- 2.2 Eligible Teams may enter by completing the attached form and sending it to the St Francis Yacht Club race office by Sept 28th, 2005 at 1700 hours. Forms may also be found on the web site or picked up at St Francis.
- 2.3 No student below the level of 9<sup>th</sup> grade shall be eligible to compete.

**3.0 FEES**

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$25. Bagels and Lunch are included both days.

**5.5 BOATS**

All Teams must supply their own class legal Laser Full Rig.

**6.0 RACING AREA**

The intended race area will be set on the City Front utilizing inflatable marks.

**7.0 SCORING and PRIZES**

- 7.1 One race will constitute a series. PR 7.4 (b) and (c) are deleted
- 7.2 There will not be no throw-out races in this series.
- 7.3 Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third.

**8.0 BERTHING**

If you plan on leaving a trailer in the City parking lot prior to Saturday morning or overnight on Sunday, please contact the Harbor Master's Office 415-292-2013 for an overnight parking permit. All trailers will be towed without a city permit. On Saturday night, all boats & trailers should be stored at the direction of the StFYC Dock Master.
