RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the 2005-2008 ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA); this Notice of Race and by the Sailing Instructions, all of which supplement or modify the former.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY

Entry will be accepted from Full-Rig and Radial sailors who are full-time students, 9th grade and above and enrolled in an ISSA and PCISA member school.

Sailors may enter by completing the Entry Form and Release of Liability Form (signed by parent or guardian).

Entry/Release of Liability application must be received at Coronado Yacht Club by 5PM on Monday September 25th. Entry fee must be paid before Skipper's Meeting.

FEE'S

Entry fee is \$25 per competitor and includes 2 continental breakfasts and 2 lunches. Entries received after the above mentioned entry deadline must pay \$40 to enter.

Sailing Instructions will be available on Friday and Saturday at Check-in.

BOATS

All sailors must bring their own Class legal Laser with Full-Rig or Radial Rig and all related equipment. There will be no boat rotations.

RACING AREA

The intended race area will be in South San Diego bay.

There will be separate race courses for Full Rig and Radials. Full Rigs will be on the south course (farthest from CYC), and Radials on north course.

COURSES

Courses will follow ISSA PR 7.7(a).

Race Committee will display courses prior to the warning signal for the next start.

COACHING

Coaching will only be allowed from a designated safety or spectator boat in designated coaching areas.

The Race Committee may exclude a coach or coaches from contacting sailors on the water if they deem necessary.

See Safety below for further guidelines.

SCORING / AWARDS

Three (3) races shall constitute a complete regatta.

There will be no throw-outs in this regatta.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

SAFETY / CONDUCT

Competitors must wear a properly secured U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket (type 3 minimum) at all times when on the water.

Designated safety / coach boats must monitor the VHF channel designated by the Race Committee at all times. In addition, safety / coach boat operators shall be prepared to monitor and/or assist any sailor(s) in danger.

No competitor shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. Infringements of this regulation will be the basis for disciplinary action. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the time the sailors arrives onto Coronado YC property until they depart at the conclusion of all regatta activities.

No competitor shall discard any trash on the ground or in the water at any time during the event.

SPECIAL RULES

Boats and trailers may be parked in the CYC parking lot for the duration of the regatta.

Parking of cars in CYC Main Lot is reserved for CYC members. Parking is available to Non-Members in any space in the CYC South Lot or on the nearby street.

Cars may enter CYC Main Lot for loading and unloading of gear and trailers.

The CYC Bar is off-limits to anyone under the age of 21.
