NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ISSA Procedural Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all ISSA member schools
- 2.2 Eligible teams may enter by completing the registration form online at www.stfyc.com
- 2.3 Entries must be received by 1700, March 21, 2007.

3.0 FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$25 per sailor.

4.0 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Racing will be held on Saturday, March 24 & Sunday, March 25.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day is 1100 hours. A Sailors' Meeting will be held at 1000 hours on Saturday, March 24.
- 4.4 Competitors and their guests are welcome to attend a trophy with light appetizers ceremony following the conclusion of racing on Sunday.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the check-in before the Sailors' Meeting, while an unofficial copy may be found on the www.stfyc.com by Wednesday, March 21, 2007.

6.0 ROTATION

- 6.1 There will be no rotation. **All teams must bring 2 class legal CFJs, one for A div and one for B div.**

7.0 LUNCHES

- 7.1 Lunches will be provided, depending on condition they will be distributed on the dock during a lunch break or on the water.

8.0 RACING AREA

The intended race area will be either the water between Fort Mason and the San Francisco Marina or Blackaller Cove .75 miles East of the Golden Gate Bridge south tower.

9.0 SCORING

- 9.1 One race shall constitute a series and all races shall count towards a boats final score.
- 9.2 Each boat must have either a unique sail number or name printed in large letters on the mainsail.

10.0 STORAGE

- 10.1 If you plan on leaving a trailer please park it in the spaces immediately East of the clubhouse.
- 10.2 Saturday night all boats must either be stored on the dinghy dock or the grass East of the clubhouse.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
