



2007 ANTEATER REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE



December 8-9, 2007

Hosted by the UCI Sailing Team @ NYHC

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the ISSA procedural rules.
- 1.2 USGG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. All competitors must supply their own PFD's.
- 1.3 Each entered team is required to provide one (1) class legal CFJ.
- 1.5 Each boat is required to use a sail issued by PCISA.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to teams which are current members of PCISA. A maximum of 60 teams will be accepted to the regatta.
- 2.2 Competitors must be accompanied by a designated adult chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach or parent.
- 2.3 Each eligible team may enter one varsity team which shall consist of two (2) skippers and two (2) crews and their alternates.
- 2.4 Junior Varsity teams are eligible for entry after being approved by PCISA, and shall consist of two (2) skippers and two (2) crews, and their alternates. Interested JV teams should contact Mike Segerblom, (562) 433-7939 for approval.
- 2.5 Completed entry forms, \$100 entry fee and \$10 PSCIA sail fee must be submitted online at www.nhyc.org on or before Monday 12/3/07. **Late entries will not be accepted.**

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-in on Saturday, December 8, 2007.

5. FORMAT

- 5.1 The regatta will be sailed in two fleets which will be divided into two divisions, A and B. PCISA reserves the right to assign teams to fleets.
- 5.2 All races will be sailed in a Round Robin format. The number of races will be based on the number of entrants.

6. COURSE

- 6.1 The racing area will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.
- 6.2 The course may be any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 Three (3) races for each division will constitute a series.
- 7.2 The Low-Point Scoring system of Appendix A will apply, except that each boat's score will be the sum of her scores for all races.
- 7.3 Teams shall be ranked within their fleet, after adding their division series scores, in order of lowest total score first and highest total score last, subject to ISSA Procedural Rules 11(b) & 11(c).

8. COACHING/SPECTATOR BOATS

- 8.1 Coach boats and spectator boats will not be provided. All coaching shall be done from the NHYC Main Dock.
- 8.2 Spectator boats will stay off the course at all times, and shall have no contact with any competitor who is *racing* except when rendering assistance under RRS 1.1, or as directed by the Race Committee.
- 8.3 The penalty for failing to comply with these requirements will be dealt with in accordance to the ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. CODE OF CONDUCT

- 9.1 Competitors shall comply with any reasonable request from any official, including while at attendance at official functions, and shall not behave so as to bring the event into disrepute. The penalty for breaking the SI is at the discretion of the PC and may include exclusion from further participation in the event, or the withdrawal of any prize.
- 9.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
