1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the PCISA Supplemental Rules, the rules of the CFJ class; and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions); and by these Sailing Instructions

2. ELIGIBILITY & REGISTRATION:

2.1 This regatta is open to all High School Teams. Teams may enter by filing an entry with Richmond Yacht Club using the accompanying Entry form, by **Jan 16th, 2008**. Entry fee may be paid on regatta day.

2.2 The entry fee is \$25.00 per competitor. Make checks payable to RYC. Fee will include lunch and continental breakfast.

2.3 Schools may enter as many teams as they choose. If your school does not have sufficient sailors to form the necessary teams, we will attempt to "mix and match" sailors from different schools. If your school has more than one team please enter on separate registration sheets as team 1, 2, 3, etc.

2.4 Each Team is responsible for having medical release forms on site at the regatta

3. BOATS & RACING:

3.1 Each entered team is responsible for providing two class legal CFJ boats and two class legal sets of sails (main and jib) one for "A" team and one for "B" team.

3.2 EACH SAIL WILL HAVE A UNIQUE SAIL NUMBER INCLUDING YACHT CLUB/SCHOOL/ORGANIZATION DESIGNATION examples: RYC 1, OAK 1, PYSF 1.

3.3 There will be no formal rotations.

3.4 It is the intent to have "A" & "B" divisions START separately.

3.5 After two races, time will be allowed (determined by RC) for those who wish to substitute in alternates. This will be done on the water.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

4.1 Registration and boat check-in: 8:30 AM.

4.2 Competitors' meeting 9:30 AM.

4.3 First Warning 10:30 AM.

4.5 Awards following racing.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Sailing instructions and course sheets will be available at check-in.

6. SCORING:

6.1 The low point scoring system, rule A2, will apply, with one full rotation scheduled of which three races must be completed to constitute a series. Each team's score will be the sum of the "A" and "B" scores in all races.

7. AWARDS & TROPHIES:

7.1 There will be trophies for the top three finishing teams.

8. LUNCH:

8.1 Lunch will be provided on the water for competitors and ashore for purchase by coaches & spectators.
