## NOTICE OF RACE

### **1.0 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), PCISA procedural Rules, and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 will be changed as follows: All competitors are required to wear a life jacket or other adequate personal floatation device while racing.

### **2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 This regatta is open to all ISSA member schools.
- 2.2 Eligible teams may enter by completing the attached registration form.
- 2.3 All entries must be received by **Wednesday, March 26, 2008 at 1700 hours.**

### **3.0 FEES**

Entry fee is \$30 per sailor.

### **4.0 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Racing will be held on Saturday, March 29 & Sunday, March 30.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race each day is 1130 hours. Each competitor will need to check-in at 1000 hours and sign a liability waiver and turn in payment. A Competitors' Meeting will be held at 1030 hours on Saturday, March 29.
- 4.3 Competitors and their guests are welcome to attend a social on Saturday evening at St. Francis Yacht Club and a trophy ceremony following the conclusion of racing on Sunday.

### **5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at the check-in before the Sailors' Meeting, while an unofficial copy may be found on the StFYC web site by Thursday, March 27, 2008.

### **6.0 ROTATION**

There will be no rotation for this event. **All teams must bring 2 class legal CFJs**, one for A division and one for B division.

### **7.0 LUNCHES**

Lunches will be provided. Depending on the conditions, they will either be distributed on the dock during a lunch break or on the water.

### **8.0 RACING AREA**

The intended race area will be either the water between Fort Mason and the San Francisco Marina or in Blackhauler Cove .75 miles East of the Golden Gate Bridge South Tower.

### **9.0 SCORING**

- 9.1 One race will constitute a series and all races shall count towards a boat's final score.
- 9.2 Each boat must have either a unique sail number or name printed in large letters on the mainsail.

### **10.0 STORAGE**

- 10.1 If you plan on leaving a trailer, please park it in the spaces immediately East of the clubhouse.
- 10.2 On Saturday night, all boats must either be stored on the dinghy dock or the grass East of the clubhouse.

### **11.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
