

NOTICE OF RACE

PACIFIC COAST HIGH SCHOOL TEAM RACING CHAMPIONSHIP
Hosted By The
San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs Junior Advisory Committee
and the
Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association
APRIL 24-25, 2010

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix D, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 Rule D2.3(b) Races with Limited Umpiring will apply.

1.3 Rule D2.4 (b) regarding protests and requests for redress, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY

2.1 A team is comprised of a minimum of 6 sailors, maximum of 9 sailors who MUST attend the same high school in grades 9-12. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult Team-Leader Chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach or parent and must be recognized by the school.

2.2 Each PCISA school may send one team.

2.3 Each team must be a current member of ISSA and the PCISA.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

3.1 Eligible schools must enter by completing the attached entry form, and forwarding, including entry fee to Chris Snow, c/o North Sails, 2829 Historic Decatur Rd, San Diego, CA 92106. Entries must be received by April 19th, 2010. Make checks payable to **SDAYC-JAC**. **The organizers would appreciate it if teams interested or confirming participation would indicate their interest as soon as possible. E-mail Chris Snow at chris@od.northsails.com.**

3.2 An SDAYC Liability Release form must be completed for each competitor. These will be available at registration

4. ENTRY FEE

4.1 The entry fee is \$200 per team. Checks are payable to SDAYC-JAC.

5. BOATS

Collegiate FJs and PCISA Sails will be provided by the SDAYC-JAC & PCISA.

6. BOAT DAMAGE DEPOSIT

A boat damage deposit in the amount of \$250.00 is required before a team may compete. Any member of the Race Committee, Protest Committee or Organizing Authority may protest a competitor for damage incurred during the event. Sailors and teams are responsible for any damage they cause while sailing in borrowed boats.

All times are approximate. Changes will be posted on the Notice Board.

8. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be in the North end Mission Bay, San Diego. The regatta will be staged from the North end of Santa Clara Point. Team members, coaches and spectators will be able to watch the racing from the shore on Santa Clara Point and rotations will be on the beach. See attached map of location. Please note that this event is being run under a permit issued by the City of San Diego and all competitors are asked to be good neighbors to other using the public park.

9. COURSES/FORMAT

Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7.

10. SCORING

The regatta will be scored using ISSA Procedural rules.

11. HOUSING

Teams are responsible for their own housing. Contact Chris Snow if you need information on hotels close to the venue.

12. COACHING

Team-leaders, chaperones, advisors, coaches and other support personnel shall not have any contact with the competitors while afloat in the sailing area from April 24 through April 25, 2009 unless with the permission of the Race Committee. All coaching, crew rotation, exchange of clothing/food/drink and communication shall only occur on the beach unless otherwise instructed by the Race Committee. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

13. PRIZES

The winning team will have their name engraved on the PCISA Team Race Championship Trophy housed at US Sailing Center, Long Beach. The top three teams will qualify for the 2010 ISSA Baker Team Race Nationals to be held May 21-23 at Sail Sand Point in Seattle, WA. More information can be found at www.highschoolsailing.org.

14. OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during April 18 or 19, 2009 may be the basis for disciplinary action. Discipline problems and this regulation's enforcement will be handled promptly by an adult Discipline Hearing Board which will consist of three adult members; the Regatta Chairperson, a PCISA Officer and the Chief Judge. Said Board shall, at a time and method selected by them, meet to hear said problem and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the entire regatta, shall be final without appeal permitted.

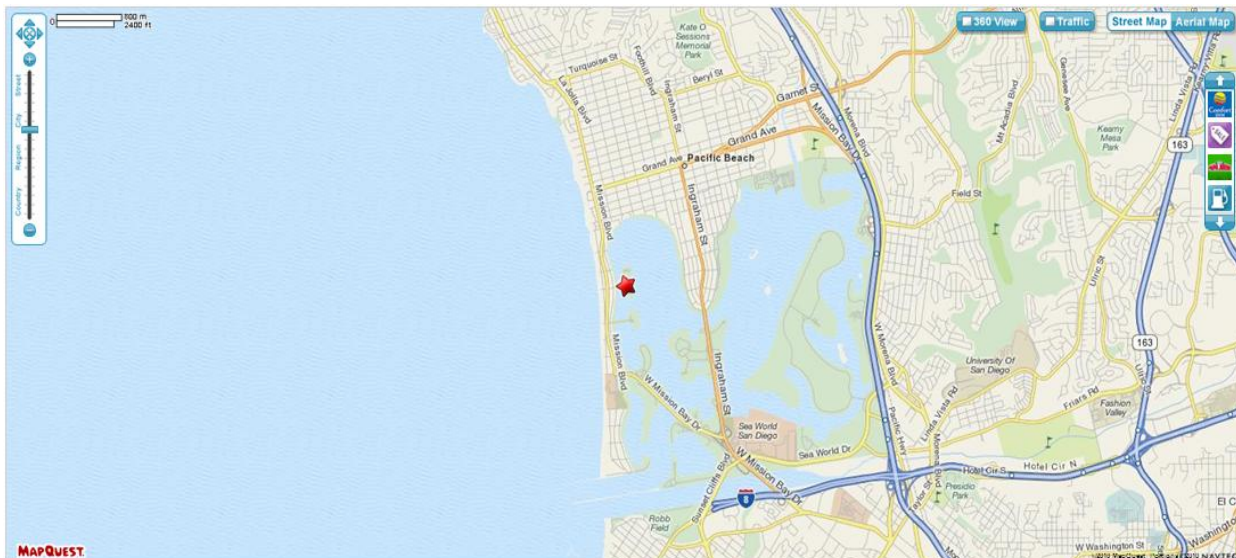

Parent's Consent and Waiver of Liability

Assumption of Risk – Indemnity Agreement

The undersigned parents or legal Guardians (hereafter referred to in the singular) of (herein referred to as the "child"), request that the child be allowed to participate at any San Diego Area Yacht Club in any Junior activity (herein referred to as "the activities").

This agreement shall remain in effect until San Diego Area Yacht Club Junior committee receives written notice of the cancellation of the consent or until the end of the activities described above.

In return for the child being permitted to take part in the activities and to use the facilities and property of any San Diego Area Yacht Club each of us makes the following promises and warrants the truth of the following facts:

1. I am familiar with the programs included in the activities and I understand officers and employees of any San Diego Area Yacht Club are available to discuss the activities if I should wish additional information. I also understand I am solely responsible for the arrival and departure of my child at the beginning and end of each day's activity. I will not allow my child to remain on the premises of any San Diego Area Yacht Club after each day's program without appropriate supervision or the written permission of the Yacht Club. I agree San Diego Area Yacht Clubs will have no responsibility for the supervision of my child at times other than during the scheduled activities. I will inform my child that he/she is expected to cooperate with and follow the directions of the person in charge of the activities and to act in a manner consistent with the spirit of good sportsmanship and respect for the rights of others.

2. My child is in good health and I know of no reason why he/she would be incapable of participating in the activities. My child knows how to swim. I will immediately notify the designated San Diego Area Yacht Club supervisor if a change in my child's health or other condition affects my child's ability to participate in the activities.

3. W AIVER OF LIABILITY: I waive and release any right I, my heirs, distributees, guardians, legal representatives and assigns may have or acquire to make a claim against, sue, attach the property of or prosecute any San Diego Area Yacht Club or any of its directors, officials, agents, employees and affiliated organizations (herein referred to as "the releases") for monetary damages caused by injury to my child or damage to the property of my child or myself arising from my child's participation in the activities and use of the facilities and property of any San Diego Area Yacht Club, whether or not the injury or damage results from the negligence or other action, except irrational acts, or any of the releases.

4. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I am aware that the activities may involve maneuvering a boat, sailboard or other watercraft on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include among other things, strong winds and high waves, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with other watercraft and or stationary objects such as docks, pilings and buoys. With knowledge of the dangers involved I voluntarily ask that my child be allowed to take part in the activities. I ACCEPT ANY AND ALL RISKS TO MYSELF AND MY CHILD OF INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE ARISING FROM PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES AND THE USE OF THE FACILITIES AND PROPERTY OF ANY AREA SAN DIEGO YACHT CLUB, WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER ACTION, EXCEPT INTENTIONAL ACTS OF ANY OF THE RELEASES.

5. INDEMNITY AGREEMENT: I agree to indemnify and hold the releaseses harmless from any loss, liability, damage or cost including reasonable attorneys fees that may occur due to my child's participation in the activities and use whether or not such loss, liability, damage or cost results from the negligence or other action, except intentional acts, of any of the releaseses.
