Rigging, Launching and Dolly Storage

All boats, dollies and vehicles with trailers must stay within the area designated by orange cones with in the UH Sailing Center facilities. Teams should rig their boats and then transit to the launching ramp area, complete final rigging and then launch their boat on the ramp, returning dollies to the dolly storage area. Teams may not use the launch ramp or docks for rigging or boat storage. Please do not bring your boats outside the designated area until after the skippers' meeting.

Charter Boat & Availability

A limited number of charter boats will be made available on a first come, first served basis. A charter fee of \$100.00 should accompany the Entry Form. A Damage Deposit of \$250.00 should be made out on a separate check. The Damage Deposit will be returned at the end of the regatta upon completion of boat inspection and confirmation of no damage.
