Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING; the 2009-2012 ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA); this Notice of Race and by the Sailing Instructions, all of which supplement or modify the former.

Entries/Eligibility: All Registered PCISA Member Schools are welcome. Each school may enter as many boats as desired by completing the entry form(s) and Release of Liability Form (signed by Parent or Guardian) attached.

Entries must be mailed (postmarked) or faxed to SFYC by September 19 @ 5pm.

Format: This will be a non-rotational regatta. The boat brought will be the boat sailed in all races. This changes ISSA Rule 7.6(a).

Racing Area/Spectating/Coaching: Races will be held off Fort Knox (west side of Angel Island). Pre-approved coaches will be provided group coachboats by SFYC. Please contact Forrest to request space on coachboats, or to request to bring and share your own. Angel Island is very close by and can be great for spectating after a short hike. Ferry service is available from downtown Tiburon.

Parking/Boat Storage: Boat, trailer and parking space will be limited. Please maximize efficiency by loading trailers full (trailer pooling), bring dollies for each boat and car pool as much as possible. Trailers must be parked in a designated area, and rigging should be done at the far south end of the parking lot close to the dock ramps.

Safety: US Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type 3, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.
