

NOTICE OF RACE
"Oyster Shell Regatta"
Nor-Cal #9 & #10
January 28-29, 2012

HOSTS: Oyster Point Yacht Club, Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation, and the Oyster Point Marina

LOCATION: Oyster Point Marina.

ELIGIBILITY: Schools may enter multiple Gold and Silver teams.

ENTRY FEE: \$20 per sailor per day or \$35 per sailor for both days. Entry fee includes racing, meals (see meals below) and awards.

Please make checks payable to Oyster Point Yacht Club (OPYC). Payable by check Saturday morning.

BOATS: Each team of two is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ with sails. Sail numbers will be used.

RULES: (1) Regatta will be governed by the 2008-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the ISSA Procedural Rules (PR), the rules of the CFJ class except as to class membership, the Notice of Race and by the Sailing Instructions.

This should be modified as follows:

RULES: The RRS of 2009-2012 apply, as modified by PCISA, ISSA, the revised provisions for 2010-2011 Nor-Cal league regattas (see below), and the Sailing Instructions. Each boat will be required to display a distinct sail number.

FORMAT: (2)

: A team will consist of one boat. High schools with only one sailor may complete a team with a crew member from a different high school.

This is not entirely accurate. Please include the entire provisions of NorCal right in the NOR, as I did in the Pumpkin regatta. It's a little long, but it continues to be important to educate the teams on these rules:

2010-2011 NorCal League Provisions will apply:

Format

- Each team must provide one class legal CFJ, sails and rigging.
- A team consists of 2 sailors who attend the same school.
- Each team will race in either Gold or Silver division. These divisions will be predetermined by the teams' own coaches.
- Gold and Silver fleets will start separately.
- No scores will be combined between school and/or fleets.
- Awards for top 3 in each fleet.

Definition of a Team:

- A team is comprised of one boat. Schools can have as many teams as they would like to register.
- Each team shall be registered to compete in either the Gold or Silver fleet, as designated by their coach, and as indicated at time of registration
- If your school has more than one team please enter as team Gold 1, 2; Silver 1,2, 3 etc.
- Limits on Substitutes:
 - o There shall be no limitations on substitutions within a High School roster during a regatta with one exception: after competing as a skipper, an individual shall not sail as a skipper for another team in either division.
 - o In order to maintain the gold vs. silver fleet integrity, when substituting skippers, coaches are encouraged to replace gold

skippers with gold caliber substitutes, and silver skippers with silver substitutes.

- o At a given NorCal regatta, there can be no more than one boat from a given HS using a substitute crew from another school. This cuts across participants in the Gold or Silver division, full or split teams. In other words, if there are 2 boats participating at a NorCal regatta from Big Bear High School, at least one of them must have both the skipper and crew from the same school...this to avoid having the two kids from Big Bear split up and sail two boats with two substitute crews, since that allowing this would work against motivating the longer term growth of each participating team.

ROTATION: This is not a rotational event but substitutions may be made between races.

REGISTRATION: You can register online at www.pysf.us or download the entry form and Fax it to (650) 493-4748. Online registration will close January 26th.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Copies of the Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at registration.
